EducationUSA Advising Center launched following U.S. Vice President Kamala Harris's Visit to Singapore

AmCham Singapore partners XCL Education to support access to U.S. tertiary school advisory services and U.S. education opportunities

1 September 2021 (Singapore) – The American Chamber of Commerce in Singapore (AmCham) and one of Southeast Asia's leading education groups XCL Education announced today the launch of the EducationUSA Advising Center located at the XCL World Academy, the flagship school of XCL Education.
