Singapore, April 14, 2023 - The American Chamber of Commerce in Singapore (AmCham Singapore) held its milestone 50<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting (AGM) as well as the recognition of outstanding corporate social responsibility (CSR) practitioners, with Singapore's President Mdm. Halimah Yacob this morning.

Attended by over 200 AmCham Singapore members and sponsors, the event saw a record number of recipients for the AmCham Corporate and Societal Action: Recognition for Excellence in Singapore (CARES) awards and the participation of partners from the charity and non-profit sector.

President Halimah said in her remarks, "Today, I am pleased to present the AmCham CARES awards. The AmCham CARES programme plays an important role in fostering Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) among AmCham members, encouraging corporations to give back to the communities among which they work and live.

In his remarks, the U.S. Ambassador to Singapore H.E. Jonathan Kaplan said, "The CARES program by AmCham Singapore plays a vital role in highlighting the significant impact American companies have on Singapore's society. AmCham CARES was launched in 2016 to mark the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between Singapore and the U.S. and recognizes AmCham member companies in Singapore that have demonstrated a strong understanding of the link between responsible business operations and positive societal impact, and that conduct business in a way that creates both long-term economic and social value for Singapore. The program is a platform to benchmark, and share best practices, as well as encourage member companies to improve their current CSR programs. The process is led by the AmCham Social Impact Taskforce, who assessed AmCham member CSR programs on four main factors – communications, measurement, strategy, and sustainability.

During the presentation of AmCham CARES Recipients, Mr. Choo Hua Wee, AmCham Governor and Chair of the Social Impact Taskforce, was honored to recognize 65 AmCham members for their excellent CSR programs in 2022 and 14 members for their continued and well-established CSR practices under the special 'Commendable Commitment to CSR' Awards.
