April 28, 2025, SINGAPORE - The American Chamber of Commerce in Singapore (AmChamSG) held its 52nd Annual General Meeting (AGM) as well as the recognition of outstanding corporate social responsibility (CSR) practitioners, with Mr. Casey Mace, Chargé d’Affaires, U.S. Embassy in Singapore on April 25, 2025.

Attended by nearly 400 AmChamSG members and charity partners, the event celebrated 60 companies for the AmChamSG Corporate and Social Action: Recognition for Excellence in Singapore (CARES) recognition ceremony, including a record number of SMEs (15%) – a testament to the commitment of the AmChamSG business community to social responsibility. Following the ceremony, guests attended the AmChamSG Social Impact Fair and had the opportunity to share best practices and explore potential partnerships in the charity and philanthropy space.
